- ❖ Roger D'Astous is one of the most important Canadian architects of the 20th century. As a pupil of Frank Lloyd Wright, he worked all his life to create a northern architecture. This rebellious and flamboyant artist was a superstar of the sixties, and then fell into disgrace before being reborn at the twilight of the century. Author of two Montreal symbols, the Château Champlain Hotel and the Olympic Village for the 1976 Games, his residences are sensual work of art and his churches are strange spaceships. For the first time on the screen, this film sets out to discover the exceptional projects of Roger D'Astous. Through its clients and collaborators, and by an original use of unpublished archives, "Roger D'Astous" is an exalted journey through a giant of modern architecture. For info: cinemapotton@gmail.com
